PINELAND LEARNING CENTER STUDENT COVID PROCEDURES 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

****If your student is sick, please keep them home! Do NOT assume it is not COVID. Call the school and speak to the nurse: 856-378-5020 x305

• IF YOUR STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE:

- Call the school nurse.
- Day Zero is the first day of symptoms.
- Must isolate for AT LEAST 5 days.

• Can return on Day 6, but <u>only</u> if their symptoms have improved, AND able to wear a mask always during school hours.

• if a mask cannot be worn correctly by the student, they must stay home for 5 more days, and then return on day 11.

• IF YOUR STUDENT HAS COVID-LIKE SYMPTOMS:

- They should stay home until:
 - the symptoms go away <u>OR</u>
 - they have a note from a doctor with a <u>diagnosis</u> other than COVID <u>OR</u>
 - they have negative COVID test results:
 - At-home tests are acceptable with documented proof, however a 2nd COVID test should be taken 48 hours later, and mask-wearing is recommended at school until receiving two negative results.

• IF YOUR STUDENT HAS A CLOSE CONTACT at school or home:

- No required quarantine.
- Mask protocols:
 - A mask is recommended for 10 days (vaccinated or unvaccinated).
- We encourage a COVID test on Day 5 after exposure.
- If you choose to have your student stay home, the school <u>cannot</u> provide remote learning.

• JUST SO YOU KNOW:

- Because we are modifying our quarantine guidelines to allow students and staff to stay in school, there is a higher risk for exposure to COVID at school.
 - As a result, we strongly encourage you to consider getting your student vaccinated, including boosters when eligible.
 - Please let the nurse know if your student gets vaccinated or receives a booster.

• NOTIFICATION:

• We will continue to notify the entire school community of a school exposure.

PLEASE help us find a balance in taking precautions and keeping our students and staff in school by notifying the nurse of any symptoms with your student, or any possible exposure.
