Dear Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to inform you of the schedule for the 2022 New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA) that will be administered to students in grade 11 only. The assessment will be aligned to New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) for grade 10 ELA and NJSLS for Algebra I and Geometry. Below is the NJGPA testing schedule.

The plan is to begin the NJGPA assessment in the morning following breakfast. All testing will take place during the morning and the student's daily schedule will be adjusted. It is important that your child arrives to school on time. All children in a testing group will begin testing at the same time. Testing times are not flexible and children who arrive late will not be allowed to test in that session. If there is a delayed opening or if school is closed due to inclement weather, testing will be rescheduled.

The New Jersey Department of Education offers resources to families to help prepare students for the assessments. We will explain testing expectations to the children to reduce anxiety. Please help us to have testing run as smoothly as possible and assist us in making sure that your child is ready and prepared to do their best on the testing days. We ask that you ensure that your child is rested, eats breakfast, and is relaxed and ready to test.
