Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- Who will be tested? Students attending NJDOH K-12 Screening Program Option 1 (Vendor Supported) Public Schools.
- How is the testing done? The COVID-19 testing is free, quick, and easy. The specimen is collected from the nose through anterior nasal swab specimen collection. This is a self or parent-administered gentle swab of the inner part of the lower nostril, no more than ¾ of an inch inside of the nose. https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/testing/How-To-Collect-Anterior-Nasal-Specimen-for-COVID-19.pdf.
- Where and when is the testing done?
 Testing is done in the comfort of your own home, at a time that is convenient for you and your student.
- Who will report the results to the school?
 Each test kit will come with easy-to-follow directions on specimen collection, and your child's school will provide a link to report the results to the school.
- What should I do if my child tests positive?
