Travel Restrictions

Travelers and residents returning from any U.S. state or territory beyond the immediate region (New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Delaware) should self-quarantine at their home, hotel, or other temporary lodging for 14 days.

Large Group Gatherings for the Holiday

Due to the surge in COVID-19 cases around our communities, we are encouraging our families to follow all of the CDC guidelines as much as possible. Please be careful when gathering with groups of people that do not live in your household. With the holidays almost here, we know that families will be gathering. Please consider wearing face coverings and social distancing as much as possible. Know that our staff have also been encouraged to follow the guidelines outside of the school and during the holidays. If you have plans for your child to travel outside of New Jersey in a state on the travel advisory list, please inform us prior to travel so that we can plan for the 14 day quarantine so that your child does not experience a disruption in education.

Full Virtual Instruction

Pineland had to make the decision to move to a full virtual instruction model until January 8, 2021. Our plan is to return to an in-person model on Monday, January 11, 2021. We will evaluate the situation and communicate the plan to all of our families and sending school districts during the week of January 4-8.

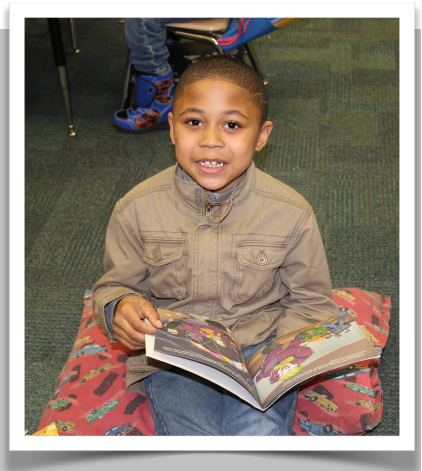
